Orientation programs for students enrolling for 2017 will be held in Oct/Nov 2016.


The program involves your child joining our kindergarten class from 9:30am until recess.

- St Peters has a brilliant OOSH that enjoys large operating areas and access to our expansive grounds

2014-2016 Upgrades

- St Peters Public School established a partnership with Tribe OOSH that provides before and after school care, as well as an extensive vacation program. They operate in large grounds and are highly flexible to the needs of busy families where both parents may work
- Between 2014 and 2016 the school significantly upgraded its technology infrastructure and students now enjoy a greater than 1: 2 device to student ratio with wifi, active panel interactive whiteboards in most classrooms and access to all platforms
- The school in 2015 established a new language program where all students receive Chinese lessons each week
- A dedicated music program was also been established in 2015 and partnerships with Tempe PS have allowed access to a training band

Coming later in 2016

- An upgrade to our library including a flexible seating space, Chromebook deployment and a maker space
- Implementation of Positive Behaviour for Learning well-being framework designed to further enhance students well being
- Whole school implementation of Project Based Learning
