

Some of our parents with children in older years will remember that the school was home for a department district office for many years. In late 2013 the office was closed as part of a move to reduce the number of offices. The school has just been advised that the district office at St Peters PS will be reopened with 2 Director of Public Schools NSW and associated admin staff moving into the offices on the south east wing of the school.
